32Two others also, who were criminals, were being led away to be put to death with Him.  33 When they came to the place called The Skull, there they crucified Him and the criminals, one on the right and the other on the left.	WHO: two criminals, Him (Jesus)  WHAT: to be put to death  WHERE: the place called The Skull  WHAT: crucifixion
34 But Jesus was saying, "Father, forgive them; for they do not know what they are doing." And they cast lots, dividing up His garments among themselves.	WHO: Jesus, Father, they (?) WHAT: casting lots, dividing up His garments
35 And the people stood by, looking on. And even the rulers were sneering at Him, saying, "He saved others; let Him save Himself if this is the Christ of God, His Chosen One." 36 The soldiers also mocked Him, coming up to Him, offering Him sour wine, 37 and saying, "If You are the King of the Jews, save Yourself!" 38 Now there was also an inscription above Him, "THIS IS THE KING OF THE JEWS."	WHO: the people, the rulers, the soldiers, (Jesus) - the Christ of God, His Chosen One, King of the Jews WHAT: sneering at Him, mocking Him, saying to Him, an inscription labeling Jesus.
39 One of the criminals who were hanged there was hurling abuse at Him, saying, "Are You not the Christ? Save Yourself and us!" 40 But the other answered, and rebuking him said, "Do you not even fear God, since you are under the same sentence of condemnation? 41 "And we indeed are suffering justly, for we are receiving what we deserve for our deeds; but this man has done	WHERE: on the crosses, Paradise  WHEN: under sentence of condemnation, today  WHO: criminals, Jesus, the Christ, God, this man, (a King – "your kingdom")  WHAT: hurling abuse, rebuking, receiving what we deserve, (Jesus' innocence – "has done nothing

nothing wrong." 42 And he was saying, "Jesus, wrong"), plea to be remembered, a promise given by Jesus. remember me when You come in Your kingdom!" 43 And He said to him, "Truly I say to you, today you shall be with Me in Paradise." 44 It was now about the sixth hour, and WHERE: the whole land darkness fell over the whole land until the ninth WHEN: sixth hour to the ninth hour (3 hours) hour, 45 because the sun was obscured; and the veil of the temple was torn in two. WHAT: sun was obscured, darkness, the veil of the temple torn in two 46 And Jesus, crying out with a loud voice, said, WHEN: the time of His death "Father, INTO YOUR HANDS I COMMIT MY WHO: Jesus, Father, the centurion, this innocent man SPIRIT." Having said this, He breathed His last. 47 Now when the centurion saw what had WHAT: crying out with a loud voice, Jesus transferring happened, he began praising God, saying, His life over to His Father. "Praise" of the centurion for this. "Certainly this man was innocent." 48 And all the crowds who came together for WHERE: began to return (home) this spectacle, when they observed what had WHEN: after Jesus died happened, began to return, beating their breasts. 49 And all His acquaintances and the WHO: the crowds, acquaintances, the women women who accompanied Him from Galilee were WHAT: they observed what happened, they returned standing at a distance, seeing these things.
